Theodore Roosevelt Council Camps operate under permits issued by New York State Department of Health. Governor Cuomo’s Executive Order #202 was issued in response to the COVID-19 public Health emergency, and this has modified requirements that are normally issues by the Department of Health to attend a Children’s Camp.
