May 16<sup>th</sup> – Remaining balance (\$385 per scout) due

OSR Troop & Provisional **Youth Cost: \$485/week\***

*\*If Camper Deposits and Remaining balance paid by (3/15 & 5/16 respectfully), otherwise, youth fee is \$515 per youth.*

\*\*The leader fee for the first 2 leaders for each unit is waived. If a unit has more than 20 Scouts attending camp, the leader fee is waived for an additional adult (3 total). See below table for complete breakdown:

## **OSR Continued COVID Planning**

The Theodore Roosevelt Council considers the health and safety of our Scouts and Scouters our primary objective. At this time, we do not know the extent of recommended or mandatory health and safety regulations for summer resident camps. We will continue to follow federal, state, and local authorities to ensure the safe operation of Onteora this summer. Currently, we are preparing to implement similar safety measures and protocols as last summer:

- **Personal Protective Equipment (face-coverings, gloves) on-hand for staff, campers and leaders as required/requested.**
- **Additional disinfectants and cleaning supplies in all camp sites for Troop use.**
- **Hand sanitizing stations in every campsite, program area and throughout camp.**
- **Additional seating areas and temporary shelters throughout camp to enable social distancing.**
- **Common use items disinfected between users.**
- **Additional seating outside of Dining Hall to permit socially distant meals.**
- **Disposable food service items and individual condiments.**
- **COVID testing at camp as needed/required.**



## 2022 Onteora Scout Reservation Summer Camp Refund Policy

Since the beginning of the pandemic, the Theodore Roosevelt Council has consistently provided full refunds for Scouts, Scouters, and Troops based on COVID-19 exposure and mitigation guidelines laid out by New York State and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.

Last summer, the Theodore Roosevelt Council granted COVID related full refunds for any Scout or Scouter who:

- Tested positive for COVID-19 two weeks or less before scheduled departure for OSR.
- Came into close contact (as defined by CDC) with someone who had tested positive for COVID-19 two weeks or less before scheduled departure for OSR.
- Developed symptoms of COVID-19 two weeks or less before scheduled departure for OSR.
- Came into close contact (as defined by CDC) with someone who developed symptoms of COVID-19 two weeks or less before scheduled departure for OSR.

In the summer of 2022, we plan to continue to provide full refunds to Scouts who have been exposed prior to attending camp, with the goal of keeping our camp environment as safe as possible.

The Theodore Roosevelt Council will again base the refund policy on Center for Disease Control and Prevention, New York State and Sullivan County Department of Health guidelines regarding COVID-19 mitigation protocols. Over the past several months, the guidelines have evolved while factoring in updated exposure data as well as including an individual's vaccination / booster status, making them complex and inconsistent.

In the coming months, the Theodore Roosevelt Council will continue to monitor federal, state, and local guidelines regarding COVID-19 mitigation protocols. When we are confident the guidelines are as clear and consistent as possible, we will publish the 2022 Onteora Reservation Policy and update all OSR attendees.
